Blow out unattended candles and unplug Christmas lights when leaving home. Be extra safe by using flameless candles.

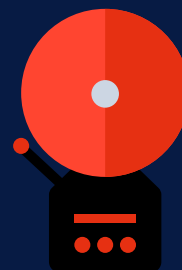


CHRISTMAS LIGHTS
